Monday 9th October

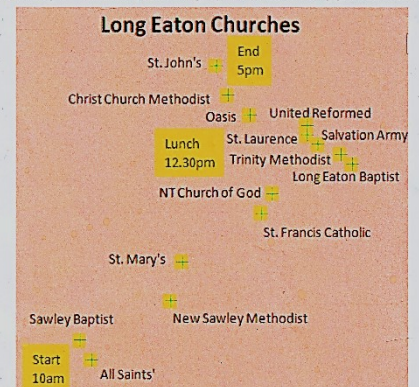
Probus are arranging a Fashion show in the church hall during the morning
